3. Assignment Title

Development of an GHG emission inventory due to WASH processes in 4 small towns.

4. Nature of Assignment



BORDA – Liaison Office, India invites quotations/proposals from individuals/agency for the aforementioned project. The assignment will spread over across a period of 60 days from 25th May to 25th July 2024.

5. Background

The cross-cutting theme of "climate change sensitivity" is to be integrated into the project interventions and municipal processes and results based on the climate specific WASH assessments for small towns. In this regard, climate sensitive WASH assessment for associate and partner towns is to be developed and tested. Improved communal WASH services that address the critical issues of climate sensitivity and gender equity will benefit disadvantaged residents of small and medium-sized towns in India, Nepal, and Bangladesh. At least 1 partner city demonstrates a 10% reduction in GHG emissions due to improved WASH services. The same is verified using baseline and endline study, calculating various climate indicators and GHG inventory.

GHG emission relevant to water, wastewater and solid waste will be considered. For the same, a framework might need to be developed that can objectively and verifiably determine whether such a reduction took place over a 3-year period. The developed framework will be used as a guiding tool to determine the same.

6. Scope of Work

The purpose of the study is to develop GHG inventory for WASH sector particularly on wastewater, solid waste management and water for select small town in India and Bangladesh. This includes determination of carbon footprint, or total GHG gas emission caused directly and indirectly by waste sector in small town. The inventory should lead to creating a baseline emission data set for small town waste sector, to be comparable with endline study estimates towards the end for 3 years after project completion in 2026.

The scope of the assignment will include but not limited:

- 1. Conduct extensive review of literature on the matter.
- 2. Review existing frameworks, relevant to GHG emissions inventory and/or WASH.
- 3. Start from the broader perspective of the entire value chain, and depending on what data is available for usage, narrow it down.
- 4. Based on the guidelines identify all source categories across value chain within WASH sector for GHG estimates. Create a framework to conduct WASH GHG emission inventory in associate/partner towns.
- 5. Conduct assessment based on data from previous inventories or previous emission estimates and accounting for uncertainties.
- 6. Collaborate closely with partner organization to conduct assessment 4 towns small partner towns for baseline study. Number of towns and location will be finalized post consultation.
- 7. Build the capacity of LO and partner staff to enable them to undertake assessments for endline study in partner towns 3 years later through half day workshop
- 8. The framework must be simple, need not be scientifically detailed and accuracy can be sacrificed for efficiency.



Note:

- 1. Travelling to the project location is optional. In case needed, travel expenses will be compensated based on actuals.
- 2. Data gathering will be supported by partner organizations working closely with the municipality.
